Important Safety Instructions

WARNING FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE WARNINGS COULD RESULT IN SERIOUS PERSONAL INJURIES.

WARNING Unplug timer from battery before cleaning, moving, repairing or replacing.

WARNING Ensure that all mounting hardware is firmly tightened and any battery connections are properly installed prior to testing or operation.

WARNING Ensure spinner plate is securely fastened prior to testing or operation.

WARNING Lightning hazard. Keep clear & do not take shelter under feeding unit during

lightning-producing weather conditions.

WARNING Feeder should be installed and used on level ground.

WARNING Avoid contact with spinner plate at all times.

WARNING Use caution when approaching feeder. Maintain a distance of 40 feet or more from the feeder when it is in operation.

WARNING Do not allow children to play with or around feeder kit.

WARNING Safety glasses required during testing or operation within 40 feet of feeding unit.

Installation Instructions

DO NOT CONNECT BATTERY UNTIL THE FOLLOWING STEPS ARE COMPLETED



- Mount small metal cone to the bottom of your feeder using enclosed pattern to determine holes to drill.
- Use the enclosed pattern to drill the six holes for the 3 hanging brackets. Mount the hanging brackets to the bottom of the feeder and then attach the kit to the brackets using the wing nuts.
- Adjust wing nuts to allow approximately 3/8" distance from the bottom of the small cone to the spinner plate.
- 4. Open the lid by turning the ever-lock screw counter clockwise and lifting lid to open position. Push on the lid and it will go into a "stay-open" position.
- 5. **MARNING** Before connecting battery, (step 6) read timer instructions on following page. Timer has pre-set feed settings.

Connecting battery immediately prior to a feed time will activate feeder.

- 6. Install a 12-volt rechargeable battery to ensure proper motor function.
- 7. To close, simply pull the lid toward you and lower into closed position. Secure with the ever-lock screw.

EZ SET Timer Control

Menu Button is used to Scroll.

Select Button selects the hours, minutes or seconds. Selected number will blink.

Set Button Advances the selected (blinking) hours, minutes or seconds after selecting with the Select Button.

The Display has a built-in screen saver. Display turns off after 60 seconds of inactivity to conserve power—timer is still working. Pressing the **Menu** button will reactivate the display.

 Connect the Battery. Important: This feeder kit requires a12-volt rechargeable battery to ensure proper motor function. Connect the Positive (+) Red wire and Negative (-) Black wire to the battery. Press Menu button twice to display Battery condition.



- 2. Set the Time of Day. Press the MENU button until the display reads "Time is." Press the Select button and the number in the hours position will blink. Use the Set button to change the hours. To the right of the time you will see "a" for AM and "p" for PM. Repeat the process for the minutes setting.
- 3. **Set Feed Times.** Press the **Menu** button until the display reads "**Feed1**". Set the feed time using the **Select** and **Set** buttons just as you did in step 2. After setting the feed time, press the **Select** button to select the motor run time and use the **Set** button to change the setting. You may feed from 1 to 60 seconds. Press **Menu** button and repeat these steps to set the remaining feed times. You may feed up to 9 times per day. To turn a feed time off, press **Menu** button to display the feed event. Press the **Select** button and the motor run time will blink. Use the **Set** button to increase the seconds to "**OFF**".
- 4. Test the Timer. Press the Menu button until the display reads "Test Run For." Press the Select button and the number for seconds will blink. Use the Set button to set the test time in seconds. Press the Menu button to initiate the test procedure. The display will read "Push key to STOP". You may press any key to stop the test or just wait and a 10 second countdown will begin to allow you to move away from the feeder. The unit will then run for the number of seconds you set.
- 5. **Wires.** The Green and Black wires are for Solar Panel connection. The Green is Positive and the Black is Negative. The Orange and White wires are for the motor. Orange is Positive and White is Negative. Connectors are installed for easy hook up to Texas Hunter Products equipment.

Before You Call

Timer operates, but only activates motor for less than one second:	Batteries must be of sufficient size to operate unit. We recommend using 12-volt rechargeable batteries. Fair or Poor battery condition may cause the unit to short-cycle, especially in freezing conditions.	
Timer operates, but does not activate motor:	Check motor connector for proper connection. Check battery terminals for proper connection and/or corrosion build-up.	
Display doesn't read correctly:	Disconnect battery terminals and wait 30 seconds for memory to clear, then reconnect.	
Motor Spins, but Spinner Plate does	Disconnect battery. Check and tighten setscrew on Spinner Plate with a

Spinner Plate Binding or Stuck:	Disconnect battery and check Spinner Plate for obstruction.
